If you decide you do not want to participate in the class action lawsuit, *Yannotti v City of Ann Arbor*, you must exclude yourself from the class action – known as “opting out”. If you exclude yourself, you will not receive any benefits from the Class Action. You will also not be bound by the terms of any judgment or settlement, and you keep your right, if any, to sue the defendant(s) regarding the issues in this case. If you opt out, you cannot change your mind later and opt back into the Class Action.
